JOURNAL ENTRY GRANTING MOTION TO APPROVE CONSENT ORDER

This matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), on a Motion to Approve Consent Order filed by Tammi Mundil, Deputy Litigation Counsel ("Petitioner"). This Journal Entry is entered on behalf of the Board pursuant to K.S.A. 77-551(c).

1. On or about October 7, 2021, a Motion to Approve Consent Order ("Motion") was filed requesting the approval of the agreed joint Consent Order for surrender of Brandon M. Martino, A.T.'s ("Licensee") license to practice as an athletic trainer in Kansas.
2. In lieu of conducting a formal proceeding on the allegations, Licensee has agreed to a joint Consent Order surrendering his license to practice as an athletic trainer in Kansas.
3. Such surrender shall be treated as a revocation for all purposes.
4. The Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, upon due consideration of the agency record, applicable statutes, and being otherwise duly advised on the premise, grants the Motion and approves the proposed Consent Order for Surrender.

THEREFORE, the Motion is **GRANTED**, and the proposed Consent Order for Surrender is **APPROVED**.


