SUMMARY ORDER OF CANCELLATION OF LICENSE

NOW, on this 6th day of December, 1999, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. The license of John R. Mattes, D.C. (hereafter "Licensee") issued by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") to practice as a chiropractic doctor in the State of Kansas expired September 30, 1999.

2. On or about, September 24, 1999, the Board received Licensee's application for renewal and check number 823, drawn on Capitol Federal Savings, Topeka, Kansas in the sum of \$90.

3. As a result of receipt of said check and application for renewal, Licensee was issued receipt # 008730 indicating Licensee's license to practice in the State of Kansas had been renewed for the period of October 1, 1999 through September 30, 2000.

4. The Board has received notification from the State Treasurer that Licensee's aforementioned check had been returned not paid because of insufficient funds.

5. Board staff attempted to contact Licensee by telephone on October 26, 1999 to notify Licensee of the return of the check. A telephone recording indicated Licensee's residence telephone number was out of service.

6. Licensee's license to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas should be canceled due to failure to renew as provided by K.S.A. 1998 Supp. 65-2809.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Licensee issued by the Board to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas is canceled

This is a Summary Order and either party is entitled to a review if a written request is received in the Board office within 15 days of service of the Order upon the parties. If no request is received, this Order will become immediately effective.
