COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with K.S.A. 77-501, et seq, and upon due consideration of the agency record, applicable statutes and regulation, and being duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:


1. On September 28, 2018, the Board issued a Summary Order imposing the requirements therein. The Summary Order became effective as a Final Order on October 30, 2018.
2. The Summary Order, upon effectiveness as a Final Order, indefinitely suspended Licensee’s license until Licensee provided proof of professional liability insurance, *or* changed his license status to exempt or inactive.
3. On November 19, 2018, Licensee changed his license status to inactive.
4. Therefore, Licensee was suspended from October 30, 2018, until November 19, 2018, when he changed his license status to inactive.
5. The Summary Order assessed a civil fine of \$500.00.
6. On or around January 16, 2019, the Board received payment for the civil fine in the amount of \$500.00.
7. Licensee has met the requirements of the Summary Order.

8. Should Licensee change his licensee status to active, Licensee must provide proof he has obtained and maintains a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40- 3403a, and provide proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


