**JOURNAL ENTRY GRANTING LICENSE UPON COMPLETION OF 35 HOURS OF
CEU**

On August 13, 2021, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) held an electronic virtual conference hearing to consider the Application for License to Practice Physical Therapy for Megan Elizabeth McCoy, P.T. (“Ms. McCoy”). Matthew Gaus, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared to present the position of the disciplinary panel of the Board. Ms. McCoy appeared *pro se* by video.

The Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the statements and arguments of the parties, hearing testimony, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about June 3, 2021, Ms. McCoy applied for Kansas physical therapist license.
2. Ms. McCoy has been licensed as a PT in the following states:

North Carolina	September 14, 2011 to January 31, 2019
Texas	January 24, 2019 to April 30, 2021.
3. Ms. McCoy last practiced as a PT three years ago in June of 2018.
4. The Board reviewed Ms. McCoy’s application for a Kansas license to practice

physical therapy and her work and license history.


5. The Board finds that to establish the present ability to practice with reasonable skill and safety Ms. McCoy must, prior to being issued a license to practice physical therapy in Kansas, satisfactorily complete an additional 35 hours of continuing education activity in compliance with K.A.R. 100-29-9.

6. Upon providing the Board with evidence of successful completion of the additional 35 hours of continuing education the Board will grant Ms. McCoy a Kansas license to practice physical therapy.

THEREFORE, the Board **GRANTS** the Application for License to Practice Physical Therapy and will issue Ms. McCoy a full and unrestricted Kansas license to practice physical therapy upon her successful completion of an additional 35 hours of continuing education.
