JOURNAL ENTRY


NOW, on this 23rd day of October, 2005, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"). After reviewing the filing and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations:

1. At a regular meeting of the Board on February 12, 2005, a resolution was adopted that authorized staff to accept surrender of a license when to do so would be in the best interest of the public health and safety.
2. On September 14, 2006, Bryan McGinley signed a Consent Order in which he surrendered his license to practice respiratory therapy in Kansas.
3. On September 18, 2006, the Executive Director found it would be in the best interest of the public health and safety to accept the surrender of license and executed the Consent Order on behalf of the Board and had the Consent Order filed in the Board office on that date.
4. At its regular meeting held October 21, 2006, the Board found that the actions of the Executive Director were appropriate and ratified the acceptance of the surrender of license.

5. The Consent Order filed September 18, 2006 and served on September 20, 2006 became effective on the date of service
