FINAL ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION

NOW on this 8th day of April, 2016, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Frank D. Miller, D.C. ("Licensee") for termination of the suspension contained in the Consent Order filed on December 30, 2015. Licensee appears in person and *through counsel* Robert L. Farmer of Nuss & Farmer, P.A. Anne Barker Hall, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. On January 22, 2015, Licensee submitted a Motion for Reinstatement to the Board to stay the suspension imposed by the Consent Order.
- 2. On March 2, 2016, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Respondent's Motion for Reinstatement.
- 3. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily served at least sixty (60) days suspension, completed and passed all five (5) topic areas of the EBAS Essay Examination put on by the Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services, LLC., and met all applicable statutes, law,

rules and regulations regarding qualifications for licensure and reinstatement. The Board concludes that a stay of the suspension is warranted in the circumstances.

4. Upon being granted a stay of suspension, Licensee must complete no less than one (1) year of probation as outlined in the Consent Order. Licensee is required to have a practice chaperone in the room at all times he is consulting, examining, or treating a female patient for a period of at least one (1) year. Further, an approved chaperone protocol shall include daily log sheets of Licensee's patient contact to be filled out by the chaperone. In addition, Licensee is also required to have a Board approved practice monitor for a period of at least one (1) year.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF
HEALING ARTS that the suspension imposed by the Consent Order filed on December 30,
2015, is hereby STAYED.
