## JOURNAL ENTRY OF FINAL ORDER AND SATISFACTION OF SUMMARY ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

- 1. On or September 24, 2013, in accordance with K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 77-537 and 77-514, and as authorized by K.S.A. 65-2836, a Summary Order was issued ordering completion of an additional twelve (12) hours of in-person Continuing Medical Education credits and imposing probationary conditions against the license of Michael C. Miranda, M.D. ("Licensee") for unprofessional or dishonorable conduct by Licensee in completing 44.5 hours of Category I Continuing Medical Education credits in one (1) day, because Licensee failed to read the reading portion of said 44.5 Category I hours.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542, the Summary Order notified Licensee that if a written request for hearing was not filed within 15 days following service of the Summary Order, the Summary Order would become effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the

time for requesting a hearing.

3. Licensee did not request a hearing on the Summary Order.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-526 and 77-530, the Summary Order became effective as a

Final Order on October 15, 2013.

5. On or about January 24, 2014, Licensee submitted to the Board documentation

evidencing completion of "Treating Anxiety", an in-person continuing education course

presented by the Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts, whereby completing

fourteen (14) Category I Continuing Medical Education credits as set forth in the Summary

Order.

6. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Summary Order and has no

further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all

requirements of the Summary Order filed on September 24, 2013.
