**ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION**

NOW on this 27th day of April, 1996, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, at the request of Manoah J. Mohanraj (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Board. Applicant appears in person *pro se*. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for second temporary registration was received from Applicant on March 20, 1996.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 10:15 a.m. on April 27, 1996 was filed herein on April 11, 1996 and served on Applicant on that same date.
3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as an occupational therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406(a)(3).
4. Applicant was granted temporary registration number 9503501, which expires May 26, 1996.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that good cause exists to grant Applicant a second temporary registration.

7. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration to expire October 31, 1996.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Applicant to expire October 31, 1996.

B. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
