**FINAL ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY LICENSURE**

NOW on this 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the application of Selina M. Morales, O.T.A. ("Applicant") for a temporary licensure to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the State of Kansas. Licensee appears *pro se*. Jessica A. Bryson, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about July 7, 2011, Applicant submitted an application for a temporary license to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on or about January 25, 2012.

2. On or about January 26, 2012, Respondent filed a Response to Application for Temporary Licensure to Practice as an Occupational Therapy Assistant, alleging that Applicant violated K.S.A. 65-5410(a)(1) by "[o]btaining a license by means of fraud, misrepresentation or concealment of a material fact.

3. The basis for Respondent's allegation is a discrepancy in information provided in documentation submitted in conjunction with Applicant's application regarding whether the father of Applicant's children lived with her.

4. The Board finds no evidence that Applicant misrepresented to the Board or concealed the status of whether her children's father lived with her.

5. The Board further finds that the discrepant information is not a material fact to Applicant's application.


6. The Board concludes that Applicant did not violate K.S.A. 65-5410(a)(1), and that as such, granting of temporary licensure is warranted in the circumstances.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Applicant is hereby GRANTED a temporary license to practice as an occupational therapy assistant in the State of Kansas.


