PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

NOW on this 23rd day of June, 2001, comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request made on behalf of Michael C. Morgan, M.D. (“Licensee”) for retroactive issuance of his Kansas license back to July 1, 1995. Lawrence T. Buening, Jr, Executive Director of the Board, presented information to the Board. Licensee did not appear.

The Board finds Licensee in default for failure to attend and participate in the hearing. After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds and orders as follows:

1. Licensee was granted a postgraduate permit in August 1994 which expired in August 1995.
2. Licensee submitted an Application for License which was received in the Board office on September 2, 1998. The Application was deemed complete and a temporary permit issued under K.S.A. 65-2811 effective November 24, 1998. Permanent license number 04-27971 was issued to Licensee on December 12, 1998.
3. K.S.A. 65-2833 allows the Board to issue a license to a person without examination if the applicant has presented certain proof satisfactory to the Board. K.A.R. 100-8-2 requires that all applications for endorsement be upon forms furnished by the Board and such applications must contain the information specified in that regulation.

4. The Board is without statutory authority to issue a license to an individual without first receiving an application and the applicant having provided the information and proof required by statute and rule and regulation.


5. The request made on behalf of Licensee to retroactively issue his permanent license effective July 1, 1995, should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the request made on behalf of Licensee to retroactively issue his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas to be effective as of July 1, 1995, should be denied.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a proposed default order. A party against whom a proposed default order is issued may file a motion to vacate the order. A motion to vacate the proposed default order must be filed with the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603. Any such motion is not timely unless filed within 7 days following service of the proposed default order. If no timely motion to vacate the proposed default order is received, the proposed order becomes the Board's Final Order without further proceedings or notice.
