COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about November 2, 2015, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* The Consent Order required Licensee to pay a fine in the amount of \$500.00.
2. On or about November 2, 2015, Licensee remitted full payment of the fine to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts.
3. Licensee has satisfactorily met the fine requirement of the Consent Order.
4. The Consent Order’s requirement that Licensee shall not serve as the Medical Director for any medical specialties in which he has not received proper medical training remains in force and effect with the Board pursuant to the November 2, 2015 Consent Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from the fine requirement of the Consent Order filed on November 2, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the probation on Licensee license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is hereby terminated.


