ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 22nd day of June, 1990, this matter comes before the Board as a result of a Stipulation having been entered into between the Board and the above-named Licensee.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts is represented by its Disciplinary Counsel, Joseph M. **Furjanic**. There are no other appearances.

After examining the files, hearing the statements of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. That, Licensee shall give the Board at least 90 days written notice prior to practicing medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings shall be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned findings. Any violation of any of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation by the Licensee shall be prima facie evidence that a violation of the Healing Arts Act has occurred for which the Board may suspend, revoke, or limit the license of the Licensee.

3. That, it is further agreed and understood that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement

between the parties and there are no other agreements and understandings not set forth herein. This Stipulation may be modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties hereto.

4. That, this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended, or rescinded by the parties hereto. Licensee may request an appearance before the Board to discuss modification, amendment, or rescission of this Stipulation and the Board will give such request due consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board that the findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board, the Stipulation attached hereto is hereby approved and Licensee is ordered and directed to comply with all provisions thereof.

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 15th day of July, 1990, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and WILFORD V. MORRIS, JR., D.O., (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Licensee currently holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and holds license number 16394; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 1989 Licensee entered into an Agreed Board Order with the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners; and

WHEREAS, because of this order by the Texas Board, Licensee shall prescribe no sedatives or stimulants for more than three weeks, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, because of the order by the Texas Board, Licensee shall prescribe no narcotic drugs to any chronic pain patient and shall not prescribe narcotic drugs for acute pain for longer than 6 weeks duration; and

WHEREAS, because of the order by the Texas Board, Licensee shall maintain copies of all prescriptions for controlled substances; and

WHEREAS, because of the order by the Texas Board, Licensee must have 50 CME's each year; and

WHEREAS, because of the order by the Texas Board, Licensee must attend a preceptorship at the University of Texas on the prevention and treatment of drug abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board reviewed

documents relating to the agreement entered into between the Licensee and the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners which revealed allegations of Dr. **Morris'** inappropriate prescribing of narcotics, stimulants, antidepressants, tranquilizers and antipsychotics to one patient for a period of several years; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the prosecution of formal charges at a hearing, the parties mutually desire to enter into a formal Stipulation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of a formal hearing and other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That, Licensee shall give the Board at least 90 days written notice prior to practicing medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings shall be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned findings. Any violation of any of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation by the Licensee shall be prima facie evidence that a violation of the Healing Arts Act has occurred for which the Board may suspend, revoke, or limit the license of the Licensee.



modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties hereto.


