Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:


1. A hearing was held in this matter before Presiding Officer Terry Webb, D.C.
2. By Initial Order filed July 7 2009, the Presiding Officer found that the respondent violated K.S.A. 65-7307(c).
3. Respondent was fined \$150.
4. The Board adopts the findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Initial Order and incorporates the same by reference into this Final Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Respondent is fined in the amount of \$150 within 30 days of service of this Order.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.

INITIAL ORDER

NOW this July 2, 2009 the above captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, Dr. Terry Webb, D.C. presiding, for a hearing. The Board appears by Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel. The respondent appears by telephone pro se. There are no other appearances. The Presiding Officer, being duly apprised of the file, having heard the testimony of the parties and the statements of counsel and being duly apprised of the premises makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

WHEREAS, the Presiding Officer made the following FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The licensee was originally issued license number 22-2021 to practice as a Radiologic Technologist in the State of Kansas on November 16, 2005.
2. On or about October 3, 2008, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of her license.
3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7307 and K.A.R. 100-73-7 each licensee desiring to renew an RT license must have completed at least 12 credits of continuing education and to provide proof of completion to the Board upon request.
4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding continuing education had been read, that compliance had been achieved, and that

documentation of the continuing education would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.

5. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and on November 14, 2008, a letter was mailed to Licensee requesting that Licensee provide no later than December 31, 2008, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education.

6. The licensee failed to provide documented evidence of continuing education by the due date.

7. The Licensee provided the Board the requested information after the due date had passed.

8. The licensee admits that she did not provide the Board information regarding her continuing education in a timely manner.

WHEREAS, the Presiding Officer makes the following conclusions of law:

A. By failing to provide documented evidence of continuing education, Licensee has violated K.S.A. 65-7307(c), failing to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of 12 hours of continuing education.



B. K.S.A. 65-7313 and K.S.A. 65-2836a authorize the Board to assess an administrative fine in an amount not exceeding \$5,000 for the first violation of the Radiologic Technologist Practice Act.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that licensee is hereby assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$150.00 payable thirty days after this matter becomes a Final Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

APPEAL RIGHTS

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-527, either party may appeal this Initial Order. A petition for review must be filed within 15 days from date of this Initial Order. Failure to timely request review must be filed within 15 days from the date of this Initial Order. If neither party requests a review, this Initial Order becomes final and binding on the 30th day following its mailing.
