FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 17th day of February, 1996, comes for conference hearing the Application for Licensure by Endorsement of A. Ravindra Nath, M.D. (hereinafter "Applicant), and specifically, Applicant's request for approval of postgraduate training.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Board. Applicant appears in person *pro se*.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Applicant's Application for Endorsement was received on March 17, 1995.
2. Applicant's request for waiver of the one-year U.S. residency requirement was tabled at the December 8, 1995 Board meeting, and this matter was continued until February 17, 1996 at 9:15 a.m. to provide Applicant the opportunity to appear before the Board.
3. Applicant is not a graduate of an accredited healing arts school or college.
4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833, an applicant for endorsement registration shall not be licensed unless the applicant's individual qualifications meet the Kansas legal requirements.
5. Under K.A.R. 100-6-2(b)(2)(A), all applicants for licensure shall present to the board proof of completion of a postgraduate training or residency training program which is at

least one year in length and approved by the council of education of the American Medical Association or its equivalent in the year in which the training took place.

6. The Board finds that Applicant's postgraduate training as house officer and registrar does not satisfy the minimum requirements and does not warrant approval as equivalent to an accredited program and therefore, Applicant's request for approval of postgraduate training should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Applicant's request for approval of his postgraduate training as meeting the requirements for license by endorsement is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as the postgraduate training requirements have not been satisfied, Applicant's Application for Endorsement as submitted is hereby denied.

This Order is effective upon service. Any party may file a Petition for Reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 1995 Supp. 77-529 with the Board within fifteen (15) days of service of this Order. Such petition is not a prerequisite for seeking judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
