FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 19th day of October, 1996, this matter comes before the Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") for conference proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-511(a)(2)(B) at the request of John Njau Nganga (hereinafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). Applicant does not appear.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the Licensing Administrator and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for second temporary registration was received from Applicant on September 9, 1996.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 10:45 a.m. on October 19, 1996 was filed herein on October 3, 1996 and served on Applicant on that same date.
3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as an occupational therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the

Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406(a)(3).

4. Applicant was granted temporary registration number 9620847, which expired September 13, 1996.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that sufficient cause exists to grant Applicant a second temporary registration.

7. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration to expire June 30, 1997.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Applicant to expire June 30, 1997.

B. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
