ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW on this 14th day of August, 1999, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Maihoa Nguyen, (hereafter "Permittee") to grant a third temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter ("Board")). Applicant appears in person.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Permittee was granted a second temporary permit by the Board on February 13, 1999 until the results of the NCCPA examination in April 1999 became available.
2. Permittee did not pass the April examination.
3. A request for a third temporary permit was submitted by Permittee on July 28, 1999.
4. On July 30, 1999 a Notice of Conference Hearing, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, was served on Permittee.
5. Permittee has applied for permanent registration as a Physician Assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(3).
6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.
7. The Board finds sufficient cause exists to grant Permittee a third temporary registration to expire the date of the first Board meeting subsequent to receipt of results of the next NCCPA examination in October.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. A third temporary permit is granted to Permittee to expire on the date of the first Board meeting subsequent to receipt of the results from the next exam. The next exam is in October. The next Board meeting is scheduled to be December 11, 1999. Exam results should be available by that date.

2. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service of the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
