ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW on this 13th day of February, 1999, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board at the request of Maihoa Nguyen (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Applicant appears in person.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

- 1. Applicant graduated from Wichita State University July 31, 1998.
- 2. Applicant was issued a temporary permit on August 1, 1998 and that permit will expire February 28, 1999.
- 3. Applicant did not pass the NCCPA examination in October 1998.
- 4. A request for second temporary registration was received from Registrant on January 19, 1999.
- 5. The date of the next NCCPA examination is in April, 1999.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.
- 7. The Board finds sufficient cause exists to grant Registrant a second temporary registration.
- 8. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a second

temporary registration until results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in April of 1999 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- That upon receipt of a fully completed application, a second temporary registration be granted to Registrant to expire on the date the results from the April, 1999 NCCPA examination are made available or June 30, 1999, whichever should occur last.
- 2. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service of the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration.

 The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
