FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 27th day of April, 1996, comes on for hearing the Petition to Revoke, Suspend or Otherwise Limit Licensure. Petitioner appears through Kevin K. LaChance, Disciplinary Counsel. Respondent appears through Mark L. Bennet, Jr. and Bruce C. Houdek, *pro hac vice*.

The parties submit exhibits, arguments and then rest. Respondent, acting through counsel, offers surrender of the license to practice medicine and surgery. There is no apparent dispute as to any material fact concerning the allegations as set forth in the petition. Upon motion duly made, seconded and adopted, the Board accepts surrender of the license.

Acceptance of such surrender is not deemed a revocation of a license. Respondent may seek reinstatement of his license upon his release from custody and authority of the federal corrections system, including completion of any period of supervised release or parole, at which time the Board will consider whether

Respondent has sufficiently been rehabilitated to warrant the public trust.

This is a final order. It is effective upon service. A party may seek relief from this order by filing a petition for judicial review with the district court. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within thirty days following service of the Final Order, except that such time is extended during the pendency of timely attempts to exhaust administrative remedies.

A party may seek reconsideration of this Final Order by the Board by filing a petition for reconsideration within 15 days following service of this Final Order. A petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.

Any petition for judicial review or for reconsideration must be served upon the Executive Director for the Board.


