1. Respondent meets the requirements of K.S.A. 65-2909(c) for a temporary permit to practice as a Physical Therapy Assistant.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Respondent shall be granted a Temporary Permit to practice as a Physical Therapy Assistant.
