**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING RECONSIDERATION AND
ORDER APPOINTING PRESIDING OFFICER**

NOW ON THIS Sixth Day of April, 2002, this matter comes before the Board upon its own motion to reconsider the Final Order dated March 7, 2002. Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board. Respondent Jarrod J. O'Donnell appears in person and without counsel.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Respondent was initially certified as a physical therapist assistant in April 1997. He last renewed his certification January 31, 2001.
2. K.A.R. 100-29-8 states that the certification of a physical therapist assistant expires on December 31 of each year. K.S.A. 65-2910(d) provides that if a certificate is not renewed prior to the expiration date, the will lapse within 30 days following expiration without further proceedings unless the license is renewed within that time frame.
3. The Board finds and concludes that Respondent's certification lapsed by operation of law on January 30, 2002.
4. This disciplinary action was initiated February 7, 2002.
5. The Board concludes that it did not have jurisdiction to consider the petition, and

that the Final Order dated March 7, 2002 must be vacated.

6. Following service of the March 7, 2002 Final Order, Respondent filed an application to reinstate his certificate.


7. The Board finds that there are material issues in dispute concerning grounds to deny reinstatement, and that the matter should be continued for commencement of a formal hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the March 7, 2002 Final Order is vacated. Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, is appointed to preside at a formal hearing to consider Respondent's application for reinstatement, and thereupon to issue an Initial Order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-610, et seq. Reconsideration of the Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's executive director at 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
