**FINAL ORDER**

**NOW ON THIS** Twenty-Third Day of February, 2002, this matter comes before the Board upon a Petition filed by Board counsel. Respondent Jarrod J. O'Donnell, PTA, appears in person and without counsel. The Board appears through Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel.

The Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order:

1. Respondent was initially certified as a physical therapist assistant in April 1997. He last renewed his certification January 31, 2001.
2. On February 12, 2001, the Board adopted a stipulation and agreement and enforcement order. This agreement became the order of the Board. Under the agreement, Respondent was required to enter into and comply with all terms and conditions of a monitoring contract **Confidential**
3. Respondent has entered into a monitoring contract **Confidential** but has failed to comply with the terms of that contract.
4. Respondent is not currently employed as a physical therapist assistant.
5. The Board is authorized to suspend a physical therapist assistant's certification upon a finding of unprofessional conduct.
6. The Board concludes that failing to comply with a lawful Board order constitutes


unprofessional conduct.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT** the physical therapist certification of Jarrod J. O'Donnell is suspended for a period of no less than 90 days, and that such suspension will remain in effect until Respondent demonstrates compliance with the Board's February 2001 order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** the Board, on its own initiative, will reconsider this order of suspension on April 6, 2002 at 10:30 a.m. in the Board office. The issue to be determined is whether the Board has jurisdiction over the certification of Respondent.
