**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW, on this 13th day of August, 1994, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the request submitted by Jacob Saj Oommen, M.D., (hereafter "Applicant") for waiver of completion of Section X entitled "Certificate of Professional College" on the application for endorsement for license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas received June 28, 1994. Applicant did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On June 28, 1994, Applicant filed an application for endorsement license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

2. As part of that application, Applicant indicated that Section X of the application entitled "Certificate of Professional College" had not been completed since Applicant had graduated from the University of Ibadan in Nigeria and that numerous attempts to

obtain completion of Section X had been made without success due to an ongoing political crisis in Nigeria.

3. Although Applicant has been unable to provide an original of the certificate required in Section X of the application, he currently holds an active license in the state of Illinois. Applicant has provided evidence that the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates has verified his credentials and school attendance and graduation. In addition, he has provided notarized photocopies of documentation sufficient for the Board to satisfy itself that Applicant attended and graduated from the University of Ibadan without completion of Section X.

4. The information provided by Applicant in support of the application is in substantial conformity with the requirements of K.A.R. 100-8-2(e).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

B. Applicant has provided the information in substantial conformity with K.A.R. 100-8-2(e) and the requirement of completion of Section X of the Application should be waived.

C. Applicant's application should be placed on the Board agenda for final approval and issuance of a permanent license at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board; in the interim, a temporary permit should be forthwith issued to Applicant under K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(1).

D. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service file a petition to review this order within fifteen days after service of this Order file a Petition for Reconsideration. A Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
