JOURNAL ENTRY

NOW, on this 17th day of February, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") for summary proceedings to extend temporary permit 9621302 issued to Miguel A. Ortiz, M.D. (hereafter Permittee) to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Board. Permittee does not appear.

After hearing statements of the Licensing Administrator and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Permittee's Application for Endorsement was received in the Board office on October 13, 1995. At that time, the application was incomplete.

2. Permittee is a graduate of a foreign medical school and pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2873(d) shall pass an examination given by the educational commission for foreign medical graduates. Permittee has not passed the ECFMG examination and requested the Board waive the requirements for passage of ECFMG.

3. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 10:30 a.m. on December 8, 1995 was filed on November 22, 1995 and served on Permittee on that same date.


4. On December 8, 1995, the Board determined that Permittee had a reasonable ability to communicate in English as required by K.S.A. 65-2833 and therefore, was eligible for a license by endorsement based upon his District of Columbia license under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2833.

5. Permittee was granted a temporary permit for the time period of December 4, 1995 through February 15, 1996 in order to allow Permittee time to complete Section X of the Application for Endorsement.

6. Permittee has now completed Section X and his name will appear on the list of licenses/registrations for approval by the Board at their next meeting on April 27. In order to allow Permittee to continue to practice until April 27, 1996, permit number 9621302 is extended to that date.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that temporary permit number 9621302 be and is hereby extended and will remain in effect until April 27, 1996.
