

temporary registration until results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in April of 1999 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That upon receipt of a fully completed application, a second temporary registration be granted to Registrant to expire on the date the results from the April, 1999 NCCPA examination are made available or on June 30, 1999 whichever should occur last.
2. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service of the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
