NOW, on this 14th day of August, 2009, the above-entitled matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) on Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement. Applicant appears in person, *pro se*. Stacy R. Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board. There are no other appearances.

WHEREUPON, the Board having the agency record before it, being duly advised in the premises and hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. On or about February 8, 2008, Applicant filed an Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas and requested that the examination be waived.
2. That Application was denied by the Board on April 26, 2008.
3. Applicant has since taken and passed the examinations.
4. Applicant has submitted a new application and is requesting that the required postgraduate training be waived.
5. Applicant provided information to the Board that he graduated from medical school in India in 1980 and was licensed in that country in 1981.
6. The Board has authority to waive postgraduate training pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833.

7. The Board cannot be certain at this point that Applicant has the necessary skills and qualifications to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas.

8. The Board therefore tables Applicant's application until applicant completes an evaluation of practice skills at the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians.
