FINAL ORDER

NOW this April 16, 2010 the above captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) on the applicant’s petition for a license to practice medicine and surgery. The applicant appears in person *pro se*. The respondent appears by and through Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel. There are no other appearances. The Board, being familiar with the file and being duly apprised of the premises finds and concludes as follow:

WHEREUPON, the petitioner moves for a license to practice medicine and surgery:


1. The applicant has successfully completed all three steps of the USMLE.
2. The applicant completed a clinical skills assessment at CPEP which made recommendations regarding the applicant’s practice of medicine.
3. The Board GRANTS the applicant’s motion for a full, unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery contingent upon:
 - a. The applicant following the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians (CPEP) recommendations;
 - b. The applicant must join a group practice and be supervised;
 - c. The applicant’s supervisor must make quarterly reports to the Board for one year;

d. Upon successful completion of the one year monitored practice, the applicant is to return to the Board to request release from monitoring. The Board will review available relevant information to determine whether such conditions should be modified or lifted.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon Kathleen Selzler Lippert, the Board's Interim Executive Director, at 235 SW Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
