JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about August 16, 2017, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for concerns regarding improper prescribing practices, adequacy of patient record documentation, and failure to furnish information legally requested by the Board. The Consent Order suspended Licensee’s license for a period of forty-five (45) days, imposed a fine of \$2,499.00, and required Licensee to attend education on medical record keeping, ethics, and prescribing controlled substances.

2. The Board record reflects that Licensee has completed all terms of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance with the Consent Order.


