SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 23^d Day of January 2003, comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, a request for approval of a business name submitted by Colette Peabody, D.C.

1. The agency record consists of the request for name approval, dated January 10, 2003, and relevant official Board records pertaining to the licensure of Colette Peabody, D.C.


2. Dr. Peabody seeks approval of the business name "Integrated Physicians, LLC." Dr. Peabody is licensed by the Board to engage in the practice of chiropractic.

3. As provided by K.S.A. 65-2869(c), persons who attach to their name the word "physician" are deemed to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery. The Board has previously opined that a doctor of chiropractic may use the term "physician" only when modified by the word "chiropractic".

4. The professional corporation law of Kansas, K.S.A. 17-2701, *et seq.* provides that the corporate name is subject to approval by the appropriate regulatory board. That law does not provide standards for approval or disapproval of a corporate name. Rather, the healing arts act, specifically at K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2836 establishes standards for considering a corporate name. Under subsection (g) of that statute, a licensee may not invade the field of practice of another branch of the healing arts in which the licensee is not licensed to practice.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the request of Colette Peabody, D.C. to approve the corporate name of Integrated Physicians, LLC is denied.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, then the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon the expiration of the time fore requesting a hearing.
