# JOURNAL ENTRY LIFTING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY SUSPENSION AND ORDERING TEMPORARY CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

On this 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 2020, the above captioned matter came before the Board for a hearing on whether the temporary emergency order suspending Licensee's license should remain in effect pending the formal hearing on the Petition. The hearing was conducted via video conference. Licensee appeared pro se. Board litigation counsel Matt Gaus appeared on behalf of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board. The presiding officer of the Board was Robin Durrett, D.O., a member of the agency head appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 77-514(g), who appeared with General Counsel for the Board, Tucker L. Poling. Exhibits were pre-filed by counsel for the Disciplinary Panel and shared with Licensee prior to the hearing. All offered exhibits were admitted without objection. Testimony from witnesses, including the Licensee, and

On the evidence and testimony received at the hearing, the presiding officer finds, on present evidence, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536, action short of emergency suspension is available to avoid immediate danger to public health during the pendency of the Petition for discipline. Therefore, the emergency temporary suspension is withdrawn

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-536(b) and K.S.A. 65-2838(c), Licensee's license to practice Physical Therapy is temporarily conditioned on meeting the following requirements:

• Licensee's license to practice Physical Therapy in Kansas is temporarily conditioned on immediately temporarily suspended if

The presiding officer may consider modifications to these requirements by agreement between Licensee and the Disciplinary Panel or upon request from Licensee with good cause shown.

The conditions on Licensee's license contained in this order are temporary, during the pendency of the above captioned administrative disciplinary matter, for the purpose of "tak[ing] only such action as is necessary to prevent or avoid immediate danger to public health, safety, or welfare." See K.S.A. 77-536(b). These temporary conditions will terminate upon resolution of the pending Petition for discipline or by order of the Presiding Officer, whichever occurs first.
