FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 12th day of August, 1995, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535 the application of Dante Perez, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, appears to present information to the Board. Applicant does not appear.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. On March 31, 1995, Applicant filed an Application for Endorsement to receive a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. As part of his application, Applicant advised that he is licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the Territory of Puerto Rico, having been issued license number 9260 on August 25, 1988 and that such license was obtained by passage of the Puerto Rico State Board Examination. Applicant disclosed no other license issued by any state or territory.

3. In his application, Applicant indicated he had obtained his professional education at the Universidad Autonoma, De Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

4. To be eligible for a license by endorsement under K.S.A. 65-2833, an applicant must present proof satisfactory to the Board that the license from the state or territory in which the applicant is licensed was based on examinations comparable to that required by the state.

5. Under K.S.A. 65-2873(d), to obtain a license by examination in Kansas, a foreign medical graduate must pass an examination given by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates.

6. Applicant is a foreign medical graduate and has not provided any evidence of having passed an examination given by the educational commission for foreign medical graduates.

7. Applicant has not met the necessary requirements to be entitled to licensure by endorsement and Applicant's Application for Endorsement should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

a) That the findings herein above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.


b) That Applicant's Application for Endorsement in the State of Kansas is DENIED.

c) This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
