FINAL ORDER
TERMINATING LIMITATION ON LICENSE
FOLLOWING RECONSIDERATION OF FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this 8th day of April, 2000, comes on for hearing before the Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") the request of Omprakash B. Pillai, M.D., (hereafter, "Licensee") for reconsideration of the Board's December 20, 1999 Final Order Denying Licensee's Motion to Terminate Stipulation. Stacy Cook, Litigation Counsel, presented information before the Board. Licensee appeared with counsel, Brian Wright, Great Bend, Kansas.

After examining the files, hearing statements of the parties and being otherwise duly advised in the premises. the Board finds as follows:

1. An Initial Order By Agreement was issued by the presiding officers in Case No. 98-00061 on April 13, 1998. This Order was not reviewed and became the Board's Final Order on May 2, 1998.

2. On October 22, 1999, Licensee filed a Motion to Terminate Stipulation , requesting that the limitation on Licensee's license imposed by the Final Order be reviewed. The matter was set for Conference Hearing before the Board on December 11, 1999.

3. The Board issued a Final Order dated December 20, 1999 denying Licensee's Motion.
4. Licensee filed a Motion for Reconsideration on January 10, 2000.
5. A Notice of Hearing on Request for Reconsideration was filed and mailed to Licensee setting the matter for 9:30 a.m. on February 13, 2000. On February 13, 2000, by request of Licensee, reconsideration was continued by the Board to April 8, 2000.
6. The Board finds that Licensee has met the terms and conditions related to the limitation placed upon his license by the prior Board orders and concludes that the Board's Final Order of May 2, 1998 and the December 20, 1999 Final Order Denying Licensee's Motion to Terminate Stipulation should be terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board that the findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board; that upon reconsideration, the Final Order dated December 20, 1999 is vacated; and that the limitations upon Licensee's license imposed by the Final Order of May 2, 1998 are hereby terminated.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


