FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 3rd day of June, 1994, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the application of Thomas P. Pirotte, M.D. ("Applicant") for reinstatement of license. Gretchen E. Schmidt, Associate Counsel, appears for and on behalf of the Board. Applicant does not appear.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On December 15, 1978, Applicant was originally issued license number 4-17906 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
2. On July 30, 1987, said license was cancelled by request of Applicant.
3. According to Board records, Applicant applied for reinstatement on August 27, 1993. Said application for reinstatement was deemed complete on May 12, 1994.
4. Based upon information provided by Applicant in his application for reinstatement, the Board conducted an investigation into Applicant's affirmative answers to questions posed in Section VIII of the application, namely the notification of charges or complaints by another

licensing agency, the payment of a professional liability claim, and the repayment of Medicaid or Medicare funds.

5. Upon review of the investigative material generated by Board Staff, the Board finds no cause exists to deny Applicant's application for reinstatement or limit a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery under K.S.A. 65-2836.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED as follows:

(A) That the findings herein above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.

(B) That license number 4-17906 issued pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2831 to Thomas P. Pirotte, M.D. be reinstated effective June 3, 1994.

(C) This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
