**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**  
**FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW, on this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2002, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the Petition to Revoke, Suspend Censure or Otherwise Limit License filed in the above-entitled matter on November 7, 2001. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel appeared for the Board. Jules L. Prichard, D.O., (“Licensee”) does not appear in person nor with counsel.

After hearing statements from counsel and reviewing the file, the Board makes the following findings and orders:

1. Licensee was issued license number 5-27828, having last renewed her licence on or about October 30, 2000. Licensee’s license was placed in expired status effective September 30, 2001 for failure to renew.
2. The Petition to Revoke, Suspend, Censure or Otherwise Limit License was filed on November 7, 2001.
3. Licensee last renewed her license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state

of Kansas on October 30, 2000 for the period of October 1, 2000 through September 30, 2001. Licensee has not submitted an application for renewal for the period of October 1, 2001 through September 30, 2002.

4. Under K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-2809(d) a license shall be deemed canceled by operation of law if not renewed within the 30-day period following expiration. Failure of Licensee to renew her license on or before November 1, 2001 resulted in the cancellation of her license and the Board is without jurisdiction to conduct any proceedings based upon the Petition to Revoke, Suspend, Censure or Otherwise Limit License filed on November 7, 2001.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the license of Licensee has been determined to be canceled as of November 1, 2001.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petition to Revoke, Suspend, Censure, or Otherwise Limit License filed on November 7, 2001 is dismissed without prejudice.


