**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW on this 15th day of October, 1994, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the application of Phillip Edward Psaltis, M.D. ("Applicant") for licensure to practice medicine and surgery by endorsement. Gretchen E. Schmidt, Associate Counsel, appears for and behalf of the Board. Applicant appears pro se.

After reviewing the application and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On July 29, 1994, Applicant submitted an application for licensure by endorsement to the Board. Said application for endorsement was deemed complete on August 23, 1994.
2. Based upon information provided by Applicant in his application for endorsement, the Board conducted an investigation into Applicant's affirmative answer to a question posed in Section VIII of the application, namely that he had been a defendant in a legal action involving professional liability or has had a professional liability claim paid on his behalf or has paid such

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a claim himself. The Board further reviewed investigative information on allegations of inappropriate conduct toward two patients.

3. Upon review of the application and investigation results, the Board finds no cause exists to deny Applicant's application for license by endorsement or to limit a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery under K.S.A. 65-2836.

**IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED** as follows:

A. That the findings herein above made be in the same are made the Order of the Board.


B. That Applicant's application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery by endorsement in the State of Kansas should be placed on the Board agenda for final approval and issuance of a permanent license at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board; that temporary permit #9500287 issued October 5, 1994 should be extended and remain in full force and effect pending final approval and issuance of the permanent license.

C. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


