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STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 5th day of
December, 1986, by and between the Kansas State Board
of Healing Arts, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and Frank
Brian Purvis, M.D. (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, (confidential)

WHEREAS, on or about May 15, 1985, Licensee voluntarily
surrendered his certificate #G-41392 to practice medicine and
surgery in the State of California with the understanding that
he will not later reapply for a California license to practice
medicine and surgery; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 13, 1986, an Order was issued
by the Missouri State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts,
that Licensee's license to practice the healing arts in the State
of Missouri was revoked (confidential)
(confidential)

WHEREAS, the surrender and revocation of Licensee's license
to practice in the States of California and Missouri constitute
acts for which the Board may revoke, suspend or limit the license
of Licensee; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of proceeding with formal proceedings to
revoke, suspend or limit the license of Licensee the parties
mutually desire to enter into this Stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of
additional investigation, review committee hearing and formal
disciplinary proceedings and the other covenants and promises
contained here, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Licensee hereby resigns and surrenders his license to
practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, said
license being #20777, and Licensee further relinquishes all of
the rights accorded him by said license. From and after the date
hereof the license of Licensee shall be null and void and Licensee
shall no longer have the privilege to practice medicine and
surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. Licensee understands that the surrender and resignation
of his license is for all time provided, however, that at any
time after the expiration of one year from the date hereof,

Licensee may apply for licensure by complying with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Board then in effect pertaining to granting of licenses and reinstatement of revoked licenses (confidential)

3. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no agreements, promises or understandings regarding any matter in question herein other than that expressly set forth.

4. Licensee has entered into this Stipulation freely and voluntarily and has not been subjected to any duress or coercion to enter into the same.

5. This Stipulation and the surrender and resignation of Licensee's license shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded by order of the Board.

ENFORCEMENT ORDER

That in lieu of proceeding with formal adjudicative proceedings to revoke, suspend or limit the license of Licensee, the parties have entered into a Stipulation, a true copy of which is attached hereto, and which the parties have agreed to the resignation and surrender of Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, from and after the effective date of the Stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:


A. That the findings hereinabove made be and the same are made the order and decree of the Board.

B. That Frank Brian Purvis, M.D. shall comply with and abide by all of the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulation attached hereto.

C. That any violation of the Stipulation by Frank Brian Purvis, M.D. during the time the Stipulation remains in effect shall constitute prima facie evidence of a violation of the Healing Arts Act and disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against said individual for the revocation, suspension or limitation of the license held to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
