ORDER ACCEPTING SURRENDER OF LICENSE

NOW on this 21st day of April, 1990, comes on for determination by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") in conference proceedings the request to voluntarily surrender license submitted by Frank Brian Purvis, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee").

After considering the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board, sitting at a regular meeting and serving as presiding officer in conference proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 and 77-534 finds as follows:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

1. Licensee is the holder of certificate number 20777 originally issued to him December 8, 1984 to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and most recently renewed July 13, 1989 for the period ending June 30, 1990.
2. The Disciplinary Counsel for the Board has caused to be investigated certain matters which may constitute a violation of K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2836 for which the Board has jurisdiction to initiate proceedings to revoke, suspend or

limit the license of Licensee pursuant to K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2838.

3. In lieu of the investigative material being presented to the Board and the possibility of filing of formal charges or (confidential)

Licensee by a handwritten statement dated January 30, 1990, requested to voluntarily surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

4. There appears to be no disputed issue of material fact, the sole issue being whether to accept Licensee's request to voluntarily surrender his license.

5. The Board, having reviewed the record herein, finds the surrender of the license of Licensee should be accepted.

IT THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that the surrender of the license to practice medicine and surgery held by Frank Brian Purvis, M.D., being license number 20777 should be accepted and said license is hereby considered to be revoked.

Notice Regarding Relief From This Order


