ORDER OF RETROACTIVE REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

NOW, on this 14th day of December, 2002, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), sitting as a whole as presiding officer in the conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533, the request of Franklin R. Quijano, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee") for retroactive reinstatement of license. Licensee appeared *pro se*. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Board.

1. Licensee was issued postgraduate permit number 94-04925 to engage in the pediatric training program at the University of Kansas Medical Center from July 1, 1998 through June 30, 2001.

2. On August 30, 2000, Licensee submitted an application for a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery, which application was granted on February 12, 2001 and Licensee was issued license number 4-29040.

3. At the time of issuance to Licensee of his permanent license, the postgraduate permit was canceled.

4. Licensee failed to renew his permanent license prior to its expiration on June 30, 2001 and his license was canceled August 1, 2001 for failure to renew.

5. Licensee's Application for Reinstatement was received on July 29, 2002 and Licensee's license was subsequently reinstated on August 2, 2002.

6. Licensee is requesting retroactive reinstatement of his license for the period of August 1, 2001 through August 2, 2002.

7. The failure of Licensee to renew his license and the cancellation of such license on August 1, 2001 was due solely to inadvertence, negligence, and mistake and was not due to any intentional conduct on the part of Licensee.

8. From August 1, 2001 to August 2, 2002, Licensee did not practice outside of the postgraduate training program and had liability insurance through the residency program.

9. For good cause shown, Licensee's license originally reinstated on August 2, 2002 be reinstated as of and be made effective retroactively from and after August 1, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the order of the Board.

2. That the license of Franklin R. Quijano, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas originally canceled on August 1, 2001 and reinstated on August 2, 2002 be reinstated as of and be made retroactive from and after August 1, 2001.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


