Upon review of the agency record an	d being duly advised in the premises, the following
findings of fact, conclusions of law, and orde	r are made for and on behalf of the Board:
Findings of Fact	
1. Trenton A. Rains, L.R.T. ("L	icensee") was originally issued license number 22-
02162 to practice as a radiologic technologist in the state of Kansas on December 12, 2005.	
Licensee's current license designation is cancelled for failure to renew. Licensee's license was	
cancelled on November 1, 2014.	
2. Licensee's last known mailir	ng address to the Board is: Confidential

3. On or about January 31, 2	014, the Board received a complaint from The
American Registry of Radiologic Technologic Trenton A. Rains, L.R.T.	ogists ("ARRT"). ARRT notified the Board that

Trenton A. Rains, L.R.T License No. 22-02162 Summary Order Licensee's certification was revoked due to Licensee presenting an altered ARRT credentialing card showing that he was registered when he was not registered.

4. All pending investigation materials regarding Licensee were fully reviewed and considered by the Board's Disciplinary Panel #29. The Disciplinary Panel authorized and directed the issuance of this Summary Order and the specific disciplinary sanctions.

Applicable Law

5. K.S.A. 65-7313(a) of the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act states in pertinent part:

The license of a radiologic technologist may be limited, suspended or revoked, or the licensee may be censured, reprimanded, fined pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2863a, and amendments thereto, or otherwise sanctioned by the board or an application for licensure may be denied if it is found that the licensee or applicant:

- (8) has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct under criteria which the board may establish by rules or regulations.
- 6. K.A.R. 100-73-6 of the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act defines unprofessional conduct as:
 - (d) being sanctioned or disciplined by a peer review committee, or a medical care facility for acts or conduct that would constitute grounds for denial, limitation, suspension, or revocation of a license under K.S.A. 65-7313 and amendments thereto; . . .
 - (h) committing conduct likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public; . . .

Conclusions of Law

7. The Board finds that Licensee violated K.S.A. 65-7313(a), as further defined by K.A.R. 100-73-6(d), when ARRT revoked his certification.

8. The Board finds that Licensee violated K.S.A. 65-7313(a), as further defined by

K.A.R. 100-73-6(h), when he provided an altered AART credentialing card as being valid when

it was not.

9. The Board has jurisdiction over Licensee as well as the subject matter of this

proceeding, and such proceeding is held in the public interest.

10. Based on the facts and circumstances set forth herein, the use of summary

proceedings in this matter is appropriate, in accordance with the provisions set forth in K.S.A.

77-537(a) in that the use of summary proceedings does not violate any provision of law and the

protection of the public interest does not require the Board to give notice and opportunity to

participate to person other than Licensee.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee's license is hereby INDEFINITELY

SUSPENDED for violating the Kansas Radiologic Technologists Practice Act. Licensee's

license shall be indefinitely suspended.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that upon becoming effective as a Final Order, this document

shall be deemed a public record and be reported to any reporting entities authorized to receive

such disclosure.
