FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 12th Day of December, 1998, comes on for hearing the Petition to Revoke, Suspend, or Otherwise Limit Licensure of Subramamiam Rajagopal, M.D. Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears for Petitioner. Respondent does not appear.

Respondent was held in default by non-appearance at the October 17, 1998 hearing. Respondent continues to be in default. Petitioner moves the Board to admit documentary evidence in support of the disciplinary petition. The evidence is admitted.

Having the agency record before it, and being advised in its premise, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Respondent is licensed by the Board to practice medicine and surgery, having been issued license number 04-22508 on December 9, 1988. The status of this license is exempt.
2. Petitioner served a copy of the petition upon Respondent by sending the pleading first-class mail. The Board has jurisdiction to consider the allegations against Respondent.
3. Respondent has also had a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Nebraska.


4. On February 6, 1998, the Department of Health and Human Service for the State of Nebraska suspended Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in that state.
5. **(Confidential)**
6. Respondent was suspended upon grounds that would also constitute grounds for discipline under the healing arts act, **(Confidential)**
7. The suspension of Respondent's license in the State of Nebraska constitutes grounds for discipline under K.S.A. 1997 Supp. 65-2836(j).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ordered that the license of Subramamiam Rajagopal, M.D., license number 04-22508, is revoked.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A party may seek judicial review of an agency order by filing a petition for review under the Kansas act for judicial review and civil enforcement of agency action, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for review under that act is not timely unless filed within 30 following service of a final order. Reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.
