ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW, on this 3rd day of June, 2000, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board at the request of Steven G. Randall (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Applicant appears in person.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

- 1. Applicant graduated from the Wichita State University Physician Assistant program July 30, 1999.
- 2. Applicant was issued a temporary permit on August 31, 1999 and that permit expired February 28, 2000.
- 3. Applicant did not pass the NCCPA examination in October, 1999.
- 4. A request for second temporary permit was received from Applicant on May 9, 2000.
- 5. The date of the next NCCPA examination is in October, 2000.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896(d), not more than one temporary permit shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

- 7. The Board finds sufficient cause exists to grant Applicant a second temporary permit.
- 8. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a second temporary permit until results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 2000 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- That upon receipt of a fully completed application, a second temporary permit be granted to Applicant to expire on the date the results from the October, 2000 NCCPA examination are made available or on January 15, 2001 whichever should occur last.
- 2. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service of the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration.

 The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
