ORDER DENYING RECONSIDERATION

NOW, on this 17th day of August, 1991, comes on for consideration the Request for Reconsideration filed July 1, 1991 by G. V. Subba Rao, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant"). Members of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") present and participating are: John P. White, D.O., President; Rex A. Wright, D.C., Vice-President; Franklin Bichlmeier, M.D.; Donald Bletz, M.D.; Howard Ellis, M.D.; Edward Fitzgerald, M.D.; Harold Guldner; Mark Hatesohl, D.C.; Graciela Marion; Irwin Waxman, D.P.M.; Kenneth Wedel, M.D.; Ronald J. Zoeller, D.C.; and Richard A. Uhlig, D.O. The Board's General Counsel, Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., appears in person. Steve A. Schwarm, Litigation Counsel, appears for and on behalf of the Board. There are no other appearances.

Administrative notice is taken that on March 4, 1991, Applicant filed with the Board an Application for License by Endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. An Order of Summary Proceedings denying Application for License was filed and served upon Applicant on May 14, 1991. A request by Applicant for a hearing was filed with the Board on May 28, 1991. On June 8, 1991, the Board conducted conference proceedings and issued an Order of Conference

Proceedings denying Application for License by Endorsement. On July 1, 1991, Applicant filed a Petition for Reconsideration which is deemed to be timely filed as it was filed within 15 days after the third day following service of the Final Order of Conference Proceedings denying Application for License by Endorsement.

After reviewing the file and the additional information provided by Applicant, the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and orders:

1. The Request for Reconsideration and additional information provided by Applicant in support of the Petition for Reconsideration provides no compelling reason for vacating, modifying or remanding the Order of Conference Proceedings Denying Application for License by Endorsement or for that Order to be set aside pending further proceedings.

2. The information provided by Applicant in support of the Petition for Reconsideration does not show that the Board reached an erroneous or procedurally unlawful conclusion.

3. That the Petition for Reconsideration should be denied.


IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that Applicant's Petition for Reconsideration of the Order of Conference Proceedings Denying Application for License by Endorsement be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Order of Conference Proceedings Denying Application for License by Endorsement be left undisturbed and remain in full force and effect. Relief can be obtained by filing a Petition for Judicial Review in accordance with the Kansas Judicial Review Act (K.S.A. 77-601 et seq.). A Petition must be

filed in the appropriate District Court within 30 days after service of this Order on Applicant.


