**FINAL ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL
OF LICENSE LIMITATIONS**

NOW on this 13th day of April, 2018, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Subir Ray, M.D. (“Licensee”) for removal of the license limitations contained in the Final Order filed on September 19, 2017. Licensee appears in person and through counsel, Megan L. Moseley. Susan Gering, Deputy Litigation Counsel and M. Katie Baylie, Associate Litigation Counsel appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:


1. On February 27, 2018, Licensee submitted a motion to the Board for removal of the license limitations contained in the Final Order.
2. On March 14, 2018, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Motion for Removal of License Limitations.

3. The Board finds that the Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Final Order and concludes that removal of the license limitations is warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the license limitations imposed by the Final Order filed on September 19, 2017 are hereby **REMOVED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
