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JOURNAL ENTRY

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon consideration of the file, applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. William O. Reed, Jr., M.D. (“Licensee”) has, since approximately June 17, 1983, maintained License No. 04-20072 to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
2. On or about December 7, 2010, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board (“Consent Order”) for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* The Consent Order contained the following, terms: Licensee was required to attend and successfully complete a Board-approved remedial medical record-keeping course, and provide the board with official documentation of successful completion of the course by June 30, 2011; and, Licensee was required to pay a fine in the amount of \$1,500.00 to the Board, and costs in the amount of \$1,500.00 to the Board. Such fines and costs were due in full to the Board by January 15, 2011.

3. The Board record reflects that, on or about December 29, 2010, Licensee satisfied the provision of the Consent Order requiring payment of fines and costs in the total amount of \$3,000.00.

4. The Board record reflects that, on or about March 11, 2011, Licensee satisfied the provision of the Consent Order requiring successful completion of a Board-approved remedial medical record-keeping course.


5. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Licensee has satisfied all terms and conditions of the Consent Order filed on December 7, 2010, and that the allegations set forth in the Consent Order shall be deemed resolved without entry of further order.
