

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 18th day of February, 1985, by and between the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, hereinafter referred to as "Board" and Lazarus C. Reed, Jr., M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee"

WITNESSES:

WHEREAS, on or about July 1, 1983, Licensee pled guilty to and was convicted of a one-count felony information charging Licensee with knowingly, intentionally and unlawfully distributing Schedule II narcotic controlled substances; and Schedule II and Schedule IV controlled substances; and

WHEREAS, on or about August 16, 1984, Licensee had his license to practice the healing arts in the State of Michigan revoked; and

WHEREAS, the conviction of the aforementioned crime and the revocation of Licensee's license to practice the healing arts in the State of Michigan constitute acts for which the Board may, revoke, suspend or limit the license of Licensee; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of proceeding with formal proceedings to revoke, suspend, or limit the license of Licensee the parties mutually desire to enter into this stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of additional investigation, review committee hearing and formal disciplinary proceedings and the other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Licensee hereby resigns and surrenders his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, said license being #10928, and Licensee further relinquishes all of the rights accorded him by said license. From and after the date hereof the license of Licensee shall be null and void and Licensee shall no longer have the privilege to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. Licensee understands that the surrender and resignation

of his license is for all time provided, however, that at any time after the expiration of one year from the date hereof, Licensee may apply for licensure by complying with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Board then in effect pertaining to granting of licenses and reinstatement of revoked licenses and by demonstrating he has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust.

3. This stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are not agreements, promises or understandings regarding any matter in question herein other than that expressly set forth.

4. Licensee has entered into this stipulation freely and voluntarily and has not been subjected to any duress or coercion to enter into the same.

5. This stipulation and the surrender and resignation of Licensee's license shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded by order of the Board.
