**SUMMARY ORDER DENYING CERTIFICATION**

NOW, on this 11th day of September, 1997, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") serving as Presiding Officer in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537, the application for certification as a Physical Therapist Assistant filed by Janice S. Reid-Amador (hereinafter "Applicant").

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Presiding Officer makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order:

1. Applicant filed an application for certification as a Physical Therapist Assistant on August 4, 1997.
2. As part of said application, applicant provided the following information:
  - a. In response to question number 3, Applicant provided no information in regard to receiving a Physical Therapist Assistant degree.
  - b. In response to question number 4, Applicant indicated she had been registered

or licensed as a Physical Therapist Assistant in the State of California, but has not to this date provided a verification from that state.

c. In response to question number 5, Applicant supplied information regarding the times she has taken the Physical Therapist Assistant certification examination but has not provided to this date a score transfer verification from PES.

d. Application provided no certificate of Physical Therapist Assistant school in response to question number 14, nor has she provided an official transcript of college record or a notarized copy of diploma.

3. In submitting the application, Applicant provided information regarding employment at Santa Paula Memorial Hospital from 8/94 through 11/96 and at G.C. Amador Physical Therapy from 10/88 through 11/93 and also provided copies of two verifications of clinical experience equivalency.

4. K.S.A. 1996 Supp. 65-2906 requires an Applicant for a certificate as a Physical Therapist Assistant to file an application on a form approved by the Board showing Applicant has successfully completed the academic requirements of an educational program approved by the Board.

5. Applicant has not submitted the evidence to be certified as a Physical Therapist Assistant under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2908 or 65-2909 or K.S.A. 1996 Supp. 65-2906 and Applicant's application for certification as a Physical Therapist Assistant should be denied.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's application for certification as a

Physical Therapist Assistant is denied.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Applicant is entitled to request a hearing on this Order, by making a written request to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, Kansas 66603-3068 within five (5) days of service of this Order and if a hearing is not so requested within the time and manner above stated, this decision becomes final and effective upon the expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
