**FINAL ORDER**

**NOW ON THIS** Eighteenth Day of October 2003, comes before the Board a motion to remove the limitations upon the license of Robert W. Reid, M.D., and to authorize him to change his license from exempt to active. Dr. Reid appears in person. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Dr. Reid's license was limited by a final order dated March 11, 2002. The limitations imposed by that order prohibited him from practicing anesthesiology, from prescribing controlled substances unless the drug was to be administered by another person in a medical care facility, and from self administering a controlled substance. -----  
-----, and prohibited him from changing his exempt license to an active license.

2. The Board finds that the limitations described above should be terminated, and that Dr. Reid should be allowed to hold an active license.

3. The Board further finds that Dr. Reid should continue to be monitored -----  
----- for a period of five years from the effective date of this order. Dr. Reid verbally  
agreed to this requirement.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that Robert W. Reid may be granted an active  
license, that the limitations upon his license are terminated, and that he shall continue to be  
monitored ----- for a period of five years following  
the effective date of this order.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon  
service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a  
petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-610, et seq. Reconsideration of the  
Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely  
unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for  
judicial review must be served upon the Board's executive director at 235 S. Topeka Blvd.,  
Topeka, KS 66603.
