



performed work experience under the supervision of a registered physical therapist.

5. Although Applicant does not have five (5) years of experience working under the supervision of a registered physical therapist, the various college courses completed, coupled with the training and experience Applicant has received under the supervision of a registered physical therapist, does provide Applicant with equivalent qualifications to be allowed to apply and sit for the examination required for certification as a physical therapist assistant.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that Applicant possesses equivalent qualifications, based on training and experience, to apply and sit for the examination required for certification as a physical therapist assistant, and if successfully passed, to be so certified.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effectively upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
