FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS Fifteenth Day of February, 2003, comes before the Board the request of Applicant Ahmed Robbie, M.D. that the Board waive the requirement that he provide certification of graduation from Mosul Medical School located in Mosul, Iraq. Dr. Robbie does not appear.

The Board receives information from Charlene Abbott, Licensing Administrator. Based upon the agency record, and upon the statements of Ms. Abbott, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Applicant submitted an Application for Kansas Licensure on October 1, 2001. He seeks a license to practice medicine and surgery.
2. Applicant has been advised on several occasions that there were certain missing requirements and that the application was not yet complete.
3. K.A.R. 100-8-2(e) requires that applicants for licensure provide a certified statement from the professional college verifying the healing arts school attended, the periods of study, the degrees obtained, and the date of graduation. Applicant has not yet provided this verification.
4. On October 16, 2002, Applicant submitted a request that the Board waive the

requirement that he provide the professional college certification.

5. According to the information provided by Applicant, he received his medical degree from the Mosul Medical School located in Mosul, Iraq.

6. The Board issued an order dated December 27, 2002 authorizing Applicant to provide an original transcript and diploma issued to Applicant by Mosul Medical School. The order further stated that if Applicant was not able to provide what appeared to be original transcripts and diploma, that the Board would further consider the matter in a conference hearing on February 15.

7. Applicant has not produced documents that appear to be an original transcript and diploma, and has not been in contact with Board staff following service of the December 27 order.

8. The Board finds that it is appropriate to deny the application for licensure for want of proof of graduation from a professional college.

9. The Board concludes that the denial of licensure does not constitute a disciplinary action.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Application for Licensure of Ahmed Robbie, M.D. is hereby denied.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-610, et seq. Reconsideration of the Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any petition for

judicial review must be served upon the Board's executive director at 235 S. Topeka Blvd.,
Topeka, KS 66603.
