SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 7th day of May, 2008, this matter comes before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

1. Timna Roney (“Licensee”) was originally issued license number 11-02701 to practice as a Physical Therapist in the state of Kansas on December 22, 1998.
2. Licensee failed to renew her license for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, prior to its expiration. Licensee’s license expired December 31, 2007 and her license was canceled by the Board on February 1, 2008.
3. Licensee was sent a second renewal notice on January 7, 2008. On February 4, 2008 the Board received Licensee’s renewal application and credit card payment for reinstatement fees.
4. By completion of Reinstatement of Canceled License form received February 4, 2008, Licensee requested retroactive reinstatement of her license back to February 1, 2008.

5. During the period February 1, 2008 to February 4, 2008 Licensee engaged in practice as a Physical Therapist in the state of Kansas.

6. Licensee stated that she had been suffering from a car accident and her husband had forgotten to renew her license for her.

7. For her inadvertence, mistake or neglect for practicing as a Physical Therapist in the state of Kansas after her license was canceled, Licensee should be assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$150.00, pursuant to Board Policy #04-01, to be payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that license number 11-02701 should be retroactively reinstated for the period February 1, 2008 until February 4, 2008, be considered to have been continuously on active status during such period of time, and the records of the Board be modified to reflect such retroactive reinstatement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensee be assessed a civil fine in the amount of \$150.00, pursuant to Board Policy #04-01, payable within 30 days of the effective date of this order, for her practice as a physical therapist in the state of Kansas while her license was canceled.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Summary Order. A party to whom a Summary Order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the Summary Order. If a hearing is not requested, the Summary Order shall become effective as a Final Order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 

FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 21st day of June, 2008, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) for review of the Initial Order issued by Presiding Officer Vinton K. Arnett, D.C. Respondent Timna Roney, P.T. does not appear. Dan Riley, Associate Counsel appears in person for the Petitioner.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Licensee waived the ten day notice requirement for the conference hearing on the full Board’s review of this Initial Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on Saturday June 21, 2008 at 2:00 p.m.
2. Licensee was originally issued license number 11-02701 to practice physical therapy in the state of Kansas on December 22, 1998.
3. Licensee’s license was cancelled on February 1, 2008 when she failed to timely renew on or before January 31, 2008.
4. Licensee’s license was reinstated on February 4, 2008.
5. During the time period relevant to these proceedings, Licensee was employed as a physical therapist at Restore Rehabilitation, PA.
6. Licensee testified at the conference hearing that on February 1, 2008, when

she discovered her license was cancelled she rescheduled her appointments and did not treat any patients until her license was reinstated. Licensee requested additional time to submit evidence in support of her testimony. The Presiding Officer granted Licensee's request and allowed her until June 13, 2008 to provide such evidence. Licensee did not provide any additional evidence.

7. Licensee testified that she faxed her application for reinstatement to the Board offices on February 1, 2008. Licensee did not submit any evidence in support of such testimony.

8. The documentary evidence shows that Licensee's reinstatement form was faxed to the Board offices on February 4, 2008.

9. Licensee declared under the penalty of perjury in her reinstatement form that she first learned that she had not renewed her license in a timely manner on February 4, 2008.

10. Licensee also indicated in her reinstatement form that she did not discontinue practice in the state of Kansas after her license expired.

11. Licensee requested on her reinstatement form that her license be retroactively reinstated.

12. The Board finds that Licensee practiced physical therapy after her license was cancelled.

13. In accordance with the Board's Policy Statement No. 04-01, Licensee should be fined \$150 for practicing on a cancelled license.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee is hereby fined in the amount of \$150. The fine shall be paid in full to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts on or before July 31,

2008.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a Petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for judicial review.


