FINAL ORDER MODIFYING STIPULATION

NOW on this the 12th day of August, 2000, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), the Petition to Terminate Stipulation of Stanton Rosenberg, M.D. ("Licensee"), and Respondent's Request for Modification of Stipulation, filed by Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel for the Board. Licensee appeared with counsel, T. Bradley Manson, Overland Park, Kansas. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appeared for the Board. There were no other appearances.

After examining the file, hearing statements of the parties and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On June 15, 1998, The Board and Licensee entered into a Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order whereby Licensee voluntarily agreed to certain limitations being placed on his license to practice medicine and surgery to settle all issues relating to Licensee's prescribing and medical record keeping with respect to patients G.G., A.R., D.S., A.H. and T.F. without proceeding to a formal hearing.
- That after hearing statements of the parties, the Board is satisfied that Licensee has complied with the terms of the Stipulation and the conditions placed upon his license.
 - 3. The Stipulation, Agreement and Enforcement Order filed on June 15, 1998, should

be modified to terminate the provisions of paragraph 10(a)(i), which provides that "Licensee shall not

prescribe, dispense or administer any controlled substances for a period of at least two (2) years from

the date that this Stipulation becomes an Order." Furthermore, the Stipulation shall be modified to

provide that Licensee agrees he shall only apply for a DEA Registration to prescribe schedule IV

controlled substances, and may only prescribe controlled substances that are included in schedule IV.

This limitation shall remain in effect for a period of at least one (1) year from the date Licensee

applies for DEA registration. All other provisions of the Stipulation, Agreement and Enforcement

Order remain in effect. It is agreed that Licensee may petition the Board for termination of the

Stipulation at the conclusion of the one-year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board that the findings herein are made the order

of the Board; that paragraph 10(a)(i) of the Stipulation, Agreement and Enforcement Order is hereby

terminated and the Stipulation is further modified as set forth above.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
